 prison or one year in County Jail.

There are also a variety of laws covering the driving of vehicles while under influence of marijuana, narcotics and dangerous drugs.

It is unlawful as well to visit or be in any room where any narcotic—including marijuana—is being unlawfully smoked or used with the knowledge that such activity is occurring.

AN ADULT convicted for this offense can be sentenced from 15 to 180 days in County Jail and be fined not less than \$30 nor more than \$500, or both.

This, then, is the danger to the individual and society, and what the law prescribes for violators.

Every person in the community has a stake in eliminating the viciousness of drug abuse and this is what the District Attorney's Office urges — the involvement of all citizens in the fight against the illegal traffic in mari-

juana, narcotics, dangerous drugs and LSD.

Many groups in Los Angeles County are involved in this fight, including the District Attorney's Young Citizens Council, the Peninsula Council for Youth in the Palos Verdes area, the Smarteens in Lynwood and the San Fernando Valley and others.

THEY ALL deserve the public's support, because at the base of any program to attack the narcotics problem is education.

The message must be brought home to youngsters and their parents that drug abuse is unlawful, serious, and can cause all kinds of damage to the individual.

In addition to education, strict enforcement is also a necessity in order to reduce this illegal traffic.

Enforcement of the narcotics laws, more than any other enforcement activity, depends upon information being given to the police.

WE DO NOT have victims coming forth to report narcotic crimes as we do robberies and burglaries, so it is important that parents particularly impress their children with the idea that there is nothing wrong about being an "informer" or a "tattle-tale" when lives are concerned.

It is important that parents be willing to have their children come forth with information to the police, and, if necessary, testify against those who are transgressing the law.

If a narcotic or drug abuse problem arises in your family, there is an immediate need for a forthright attack on the problem.
