## Adventists Will Assist The Blind

More than half a million people in the United States are blind and 40,000 more will lose their sight this year.

Pastor David H. Pillar of the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church will describe this shocking picture to his congregation Saturday and announce an opportunity for his church to help the blind with a cash gift.

Recipient of the gift will be the Christian Record Braille Foundation of Lincoln, Neb. Established in 1899, the foundation not only supplies Braille books and magazines, but also "talking books" on both records and tapes, and large-print books for the near-blind. It also maintains a lending library of both Braille publications and talking books.

Pastor Pillar said publications include full-vision books which have Braille for blind parents to read as their sighted children look at the pictures.
