LOOKINLAND UNOPPOSED

Supporters Plan Campaign Meet

Don Cortum, Torrance physician, has been named executive director of the campaign to elect Paul R. Lookinland state assemblyman in the 68th Assembly District.

Dr. Cortum has called an organizational meeting for the GOP candidate's supporters tonight, Wednesday, in the Community Room of Fisherman's and Merchant's Savings and Loan, 29000 S. Western Ave., San Pedro.

All persons willing to lend their help, advice and support in the campaign effort are invited to attend the 8 p.m. meeting, according to Dr. Cortum.

Lookinland, unopposed in the Republican primary for the 68th District's assembly seat, is a native of San Pedro. He taught at Dodson Junior High for seven years and was an audio-visual consultant with the Los Angeles City School Districts prior to being named to his present position as registrar for S. M. Dorsey High School in Los Angeles.

The 33-year-old candidate says his educational training, professional experience, and concern for good government prompted his decision to enter the assembly race.

Dr. Cortum points out that while the 68th District has approximately a 65 per cent Democratic registration, the district voted Republican in the gubernatorial race of 1966.

Serving with Dr. Cortum on the steering committee for the Lookinland campaign are Charles Soderstrom, a Miraleste resident who is Republican county chairman and honorary chairman for the assembly candidate's campaign; Louis Chavez of Wilmington, who will head up the campaign in his community; and Merle Boyce, M.D., of Torrance, who is serving as a campaign advisor.

San Pedro residents on the steering committee include: Jack Carlson, treasurer; Burley Johnson, financial chairman; George McMullen, budget advisor; Sylvan C. Smith and O. P. "Lucky" Lookinland, campaign advisors; and Gary Turner, precinct coordinator.

Board Urges Governor To Veto Tax Measure

The Board of Supervisors has endorsed a motion by Supervisor Kenneth Hahn urging Governor Ronald Reagan to veto bills proposing tax exemptions for special interests which would shift the burden to the small homeowner.

Hahn cited Senate Bill 393, which he described as a scheme to relieve the motion picture industry of its fair share of tax, in asking supervisors to back his proposal. SB 393 would reduce the assessed value of motion picture film to the same cost of the raw film, not the value of the motion picture itself.

"It would have a terrible effect on the tax base in Culver City and Burbank, as well as the entire county," Hahn said.

He also asked Governor Reagan to veto bills, if they reach his desk, exempting aircraft, boats, and other special interest property.

"These measures would only erode the tax base and leave the homeowner to pick up the difference," Hahn stressed.
