Every once in a while—know that he had just arrived in Southern California for two days of college and personal business. Freemark and Farrar Wilson, another teacher of art at San Jose State College, came and stayed for dinner.

It was a happy reunion—to see Freemark again and to hear about his last summer's project. It was shockingly interesting—so unique that he has written the experience in book form hoping that some brave publisher will print it. Some of the photographs taken by him on the project must be "thrillers."

The grant for the summer project was given him by the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education. He lived in the Soledad Correctional Facility with the prisoners, ate with them, worked with them and set up an art program in an attempt to better comprehend criminals and their behavior. In short, he was an artist in residence at Soledad, with a studio set up in a cell where he lived and painted.

THIS UNUSUAL program was a success. Freemark gave us an account of many experiences at the prison that he could not put into print, and were directly related to his art program. His discovery of a unique folk art in the form of tattoos that are created with common needles and dyes made me sit up and take notice. The things that they tattoo on themselves and where they tattoo them are unbelievable—what a great art books this would make, along with some of the photographs of the tattoos that he took.

But my real excitement was expressed when I saw the results of his eight year struggle to finish a suite of 50 full sheet color serigraphed prints in editions of fifty plus. The 50 prints represent the 50 states. As Freemark has been able to live in 45 of the states, he has been able to do considerable research and refinement to capture the essence of each state. The entire 50 prints are now on exhibition at Gump's in San Francisco and several suites have already been sold to collectors, museums and industries. The United States Information Agency has just purchased a set to show in the American Embassies throughout the world.

We represent Robert Freemark in Southern California and would be happy to show his work to interested people. This summer's program includes a safari to Baja, California, to make a movie. He is trying to interest Earl Stanley Gardner in becoming a partner in the venture and perhaps I.B.M. might be interested also, as the film will be made for television. He promised to stop on the way down to Baja—that we will be anxiously waiting for.
