Memorial Day Service Slated

Memorial Day services at Green Hills Memorial Park in San Pedro will pay special tribute to the dead of the Vietnam war—and to all those who have died fighting for a free world, according to B. T. Kenney, general manager of Green Hills.

Formal presentation and dedication of flags by members of the Ft. MacArthur color guard of honor will be made to 25 Harbor area families of men who have given their lives in Vietnam during the past year.

James Douglas, star of television's "Peyton Place" will deliver the flag dedication address and announce the roll.

CONSUL GENERAL Senor Raul Gonzalez Galarza of Mexico will present the

United Nations flag in a ceremony commemorating the sacrifice of people of all countries who have died fighting for freedom.

The spectacular sight of 585 American flags, flying in honor of deceased veterans, will greet visitors to Green Hills at 27501 S. Western Ave. Ceremonies will begin at 10 a.m.

Charles E. Courtway, bandmaster, will lead the Fort MacArthur Band and the memorial address will be delivered by Major Richard A. Johnson, chaplain at Fort MacArthur.

THE REV. Arthur Bartlett of the Episcopal Seamens Center and Bishop Burley Johnson of the Church of the Latter Day Saints, will participate in the program, then will

board a U.S. Coast Guard helicopter for a flight over the sea to drop wreaths in honor of those lost at sea.


Members of the Associated Patriotic Societies of San Pedro, sponsors of the event, will also place floral wreaths at historic and official locations throughout the Harbor area.
