Car Sales Come First

Larry Reed Sports Cars has developed into the largest imported sports car sales and service organization in the United States.

Larry Reed, and there really is such a man, started 18 years ago in a newly opened imported car agency as a salesman. Larry had the distinction of selling the first Sunbeam, Hillman, Rover, Humber, and the first Jaguar XK120 sports roadster to the late great Al Jolson.

Larry's love for fine quality cars seemed to come naturally since boyhood. At the age of 13 he and his best friend built their own car from a bare chassis and parts gleaned from the local junk yard.

Automobiles and their future importance to the nation became an important part of Larry's life, and so when the opportunity to sell cars presented itself Larry took to the

business like a duck takes to water.

One of the most important facets of Larry's character is the desire to be first. Like Leo Durocher, second place to Larry is nowhere.

The fact he could sell some of the first imported sports cars in this town, against the natural prejudice of the buying public, impressed him with another desire. The desire to be "first" in imported car sales throughout the country. In early 1953 he decided it was not good enough to be first in the United States as only a salesman but also to be first in sales as a dealer.

In 1953 Larry Reed Sports Cars at Centinela and La Cienega in Westchester was born. Larry immediately established it as the top sales agency for Rootes products, Sunbeam, Hillman, and Humber in the United States and since that date he has maintained that No. 1 rating.

Goodrich 990 Tires Used By 'Tournament of Thrills'

Daredevil drivers who entertain thousands of spectators each year with spectacular automobile feats are calling the B. F. Goodrich Radial 990 tire "the best thing that ever happened to our wheels."

Stunt men with the "Tournament of Thrills" show, who specialize in hurling cars through space, driving on two wheels for minutes at a time and high-speed precision driving, report the radial-ply tires last twice as long as conventional tires in severe service.

Jimmie Riser, vice president of the Philadelphia-based auto circus, said his four top stunt men who switched to the B. F. Goodrich radial tires last spring "have used only half as many tires as last year when equipped with conventional-type tires."

The Radial 990 is so named because its plies run radially, 90 degrees to the direction of travel, instead of crisscrossing in a herring bone fashion

as they do in conventional tires. A belt of crisscrossing cords just under the tread of the radial tire gives it extra stability, wear, traction, and steering control.

"Last year at this time, we had used 140 tires, and this year on Radial 990's we have used only 56," said Riser.

"This is all the more remarkable when you consider

this year more of our performances have been on hard surface tracks, where the speeds are higher and the punishment to the tires is greater," he said.
