Linda Blaszkouski, winner of the Phi Rho Pi high school oratory contest, presented her award-winning speech.


Legislature Repeals 1967 Anti-Parking Provisions

SACRAMENTO — A bill which would repeal a controversial measure from 1967 for residential streets—has been given final passage in the assembly. The bill is SB245 by Sen. Randolph Collier (D-Yreka). It already has been approved by the senate. Collier's 1967 law had been aimed at correcting a public health problem of persons living in campers or trailers on residential streets. However, when it took effect, it was found it would prohibit any such vehicles on streets during nighttime hours. Collier said his transportation committee had been unable to work out any legislation to modify the 1967 law. He said he would like to find a way to make it workable and pass a bill which repealed the 1967 law.


