Patrol Teams Note Dropoff In Violations

The percentage of vehicles found in violation by the Passenger Vehicle Inspection teams of the California Highway Patrol has dropped below 60 per cent for the first time since the program began in 1966.

In March this year only 593 of each 1000 vehicles inspected were in violation of any of the 12 items checked. In August of 1967 the number of hicles in violation in each 1000 inspected was 667.

Lights are still the major problem in the inspection, accounting for more than 70 per cent of all violations. Improperly adjusted headlamps are the cause of more than half the light violations.

Call-Box System Installed

The first emergency telephone call-boxes along portions of the San Diego freeway have been installed by General Telephone Co. but will not be ready for public use until June 30 when that company switches in the 67 additional units.

Instructions for the use of these phones are simple, and General Telephone recommends that motorists know them: After lifting the receiver, you'll hear a ringing noise. When the operator answers, give her your call-box number; this lets her know your exact location. Speak directly into the mouthpiece, tell the operator of the exact nature of your emergency and be sure to replace the receiver after you've finished speaking.
