Final Plans Under Way For Court Buildings

Final plans for the new Los Angeles Municipal Traffic Courts Building moved nearer adoption in action taken this week, according to Supervisor Kenneth Hahn. The eight-story courts will be erected over a three-level subterranean garage along Hill Street just south of Washington Boulevard. The new traffic courts will replace the old municipal courts building at 8334 S. Wall St. The old courts, a converted warehouse, will be vacated and sold when the new building is completed. Hahn noted that the existing courts are inadequate to handle present caseloads, and that there is a severe parking problem in the area. The site of the proposed traffic courts has been owned by the county for some time, and is presently being used as a parking lot. Ten trial, one master trial, and three arraignment courts will be housed in the new building. The eighth floor of the structure will remain unfinished so that two additional trial courts can be added when needed. A three-level underground garage will provide parking for 1,000 vehicles.
