"Who are the most influential people in the making of Hollywood movies?"

Warner Oland was the fourth Charlie and in 1931 until his death in 1938 he was replaced by Sidney Toler in 22 movies. After Toler's death in 1947 Roland Winters took over the role for four years. The actor who played him most often was J. Carroll Naish in 39 TV shows.

"How is Barbra Streisand making out in Hollywood?"
