MONTEGO BAY, JAMAICA — This is a sandy little town on the north shore of Jamaica. Its resort hotels are overshadowed now by the plush, new hotels farther out at Ocho Rios. The advantage may be that you can find less expensive places to stay—\$50 a day is about the average at Ocho Rios.

Beaches and swimming are as good or better. And Montego Bay shops are free port. All the imports can be taken out, no tax, duty free. You can take \$100 worth through U.S. Customs without paying duty.

time. You get these coupons at the border on entering or in Rome through the auto club. Maybe other ways. But here's what happened to me: I got a rent car on Sunday. All the offices were closed. When I got out of Rome, I couldn't find any place that could issue coupons.

Then I found this discount doesn't apply if you are driving a car with Italian plates. Some people must be using them though. I saw many gas stations with a big sign, "Coupons." (Apparently coupons don't go in all gas stations.)

"In Rome where do we buy rosaries?"

In the Piazza Minerva. All shops selling religious articles. That's just behind the Pantheon.

"And you mentioned once about the cats of Rome..."

I don't know any other city that has these—thousands of cats who belong to no one. You find them around Roman ruins. The Colosseum, the Forum. Best I think is around the Pantheon where you'll see hundreds under the great pillars. On a moonlight night with the pillar shadows it's quite a sight.

"Can we get Social Security checks sent overseas?"

There are some 200,000 Americans living overseas on Social Security checks.

A Thousand and One Travelers' Tales: British Travel thinks I gave an incomplete picture of the pound devaluation. Writes: "Cost of rail, air and bus travel in Britain will definitely drop for the present a full 14.3 per cent. The hotel chains are holding the line so far on prices, and all indications are that the government will clamp down hard after the first of the year on all price and wage rises."

"If we rent a car in Spain, can we take it to Lisbon?"

You can. But you have to tell the rental agency so they can make out international papers. And you have to bring it back—or pay the cost. Call the Hertz people. They sometimes have a car that must be returned. And they'll give you a better rate if you take a car from Portugal that has been left in Madrid and drive it back to Lisbon.

This Hertz special works in all European cities. So ask if there's a car going back your way and you might luck out.

I favor those outdoor places in the corner of the Plaza Mayor—El Pulpito and Meson de la Corregidora. Or down the steps from there into the back street, Casa Botin. Colorful and popular, so call for a reservation. Lechon—suckling pig—is the dish. Marques de Riscal is the wine.
