

Spring Drills Revealed

A weekend in Bahams-Nassau, a three-game visit to the Miami area, six games in Arizona en route to California and a night-and-day series in the new San Diego Stadium are all part of the Los Angeles Dodgers spring training schedule of 1968.

For some of the Dodgers, spring training will get under way since 1948. Skipper Walt Alton weather permitting. All the Dodgers living in this area have been "invited" to attend three workouts a week—Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays for the rest of the winter. Lefty Phillips and Jim Gilliam will be in charge of the drills.

On Feb. 24, the Dodgers will take off for spring training at Dodgertown, Vero Beach, Fla., their spring base since 1948. Skipper Walt Alton will conduct his first workout the following day. Spring games will get under way the weekend of March 9-10 in a home-and-home series with the Atlanta Braves. All told, the Dodgers will play 27 games, including night games at Miami, Vero Beach and San Diego, and will meet 15 different opponents in an all-major league spring schedule.

In the Miami area the Dodgers will play a pair with the Baltimore Orioles and visit Ft. Lauderdale for a game with the New York Yankees. In Arizona they will play two-game series with the Giants, Cubs and Indians. Cleveland will then accompany them to San Diego for games Saturday, April 6, at night, and Sunday afternoon, April 7.

General Manager E. J. (Buzzie) Bavasi, in something of a crackdown mood insofar as his Dodgers are concerned, has outlined a vigorous physical campaign for spring maneuvers in what he hopes will be the beginning of a "bounce back" campaign in 1968.

"We're planning two workouts a day this year and we'll have enough extra players down there to stage ball games in Vero Beach even on dates when the Dodgers are playing away from their home base.

"How the squad is split for the workouts is, of course, Manager Walt Alton's business, but the Dodgers can look for a lot more physical effort in spring training this year. Losing the pennant last year was a real team effort—and we're going to do something about it. No better place to start than Dodgertown," Bavasi said.

Hollypark Plans 75-Day Program

Thoroughbred breeders, owners, and trainers who favor more special stakes races for their distaff runners received good news from Hollywood Park. General Manager James D. Stewart announced for the 75-day Hollypark meeting opening April 9, immediately after the close April 6 of the Santa Anita session, there will be 20 stakes run exclusively for fillies and mares, as compared to 14 scheduled at last year's 55-day meet, for a total of \$70,000 added.

Stewart pointed out that with Hollywood Park following without a break upon the Santa Anita season, the 30 continuous weeks of thoroughbred racing in Los Angeles area will give horsemen a total of 34 stakes for \$1,095,000 added for their fillies and mares.

In addition to more races for more prize money during the coming meeting, Hollywood Park's championship event for fillies and mares in the Vanity Handicap at a mile and one-eighth to be run June 29, will be increased from \$50,000 added to 75,000. Distaffers racing in this division will be offered eight

stakes opportunities for \$255,000 added.

Four of the six new stakes will be raced over Hollywood Park's popular Lakeside Turf Course and two of these will be for fillies and mares three years old and upward. They are the \$30,000 added South Bay Handicap at a mile and one-sixteenth on June 18 and the \$30,000 added Beverly Hills Handicap at a mile and three-eighths on July 9.

Also new is the \$20,000 Bel Air Handicap for non-winners of \$10,000 since December 25, 1967, at six furlongs on May 23 on the main track.

Three-year-old fillies again will settle the championship of their division in the \$50,000 added Hollywood Oaks, the miles and one furlong title event will be renewed July 18.

Stakes opportunities for sophomore misses have been increased from five to six for \$165,000 added. The newcomer is a turf event, the \$20,000 added Senorita Stakes at a miles on May 31.

Each boy must be accompanied by a parent and present a birth certificate at the sign-ups. One book of trading stamps and a \$5 donation is asked to obtain playing equipment.
