Maritime Academy Exam Scheduled Next Month

State Senator Ralph C. Dills (D-32nd District) has announced an examination for young men in his district to become his nominee for admission to the California Maritime Academy in August.

The examination will be held in three locations—at the California Maritime Academy in Vallejo Feb. 3, at Polytechnic High School in Long Beach April 10, and at Los Angeles City College April 11.

Senator Dills said the applicant with the highest passing score will become his nominee provided physical and other entrance requirements are met. Others with passing scores who meet requirements, he said, may be admitted if vacancies in the quota for the entering class exist.

The state-operated California Maritime Academy is located on Carquinez Straits, Vallejo, northeast of San Francisco Bay.

Graduates receive a bachelor of science degree, either in nautical science or in marine engineering, and are licensed by the U.S. Coast

Guard as an officer for service aboard U.S. merchant ships.

Those who are physically and otherwise qualified are eligible for commissions in the U.S. Naval Reserve. Students must pay certain fees, which include room and board, textbooks, and uniforms.

To be eligible an applicant must, at the time of admission in August, be a high school graduate, unmarried, 17 years of age but not yet 22, and meet certain physical and mental requirements.


