

# Committee Mails Report On Incorporation Plans

A comprehensive report on the feasibility of the proposed new city in the Dominguez-Carson area has been mailed this week by the Dominguez-Carson Citizens Committee for Incorporation to all voters who are registered for the Feb. 6 incorporation election.

The pamphlet details all aspects relating to the area and to the incorporation of the new city. In addition to maps showing the boundaries of the proposed new city, the booklet contains an outline of the projected city budget. The pamphlet points out the financial feasibility of the new city and how it can operate with no city property tax.

Citizen control of the new city and the city's structure are thoroughly covered and the duties and responsibilities of the various elected and appointed public officials, commissions, and city departments are summarized.

The actual structure of the city is explained, along with the obligations of the City Council, City Clerk, and City Treasurer. Also covered are appointed positions of city administrator and city attorney and the members of commissions, such as planning, parks and recreation, and public safety.

The contract services plan, whereby the level of services in the proposed city will be raised, is explained. The history of the contract services plan, state law, the actual city-county relationship are covered.

The primary findings supporting incorporation are cited along with the authorities contacted in reaching these conclusions. A partial listing of prominent local organizations supporting incorporation also is given.

## Officers Named By Commission

Owen H. Lewis, former mayor of LaVerne, has been elected chairman of the Regional Planning Commission. The new vice chairman is Alfred E. Paonessa, an Encino resident and former Superior Court judge.

## Small Boat Instruction Course Ready

Instruction in techniques of safe small boat handling for both sail and powerboat enthusiasts will be offered at two Long Beach high schools starting next week, according to Fred Christ, commander of the Long Beach unit of the United States Power Squadrons.

The free, 13-week courses in Elementary Piloting will be held at Wilson High School, 10th and Ximeno Avenue on Monday evenings, beginning Jan. 29, and at Millikan High School, 2800 Snowden Ave., Thursday evenings, starting Feb. 1, the commander of the 600-member squadron said. Both classes will start at 7:30 p.m. and will be held in the cafeterias at both schools.

Subjects taught by experienced small boat skippers include proper fueling practices, Coast Guard requirements, right-of-way, rules of the road, and many other facets of handling sail and powerboats.

Other subjects to be covered during the weekly evening classes include compass and chart reading, ventilation requirements, docking and undocking, and other matters related to safe pleasure boating operation.

The classes are open to persons 14 years or older regardless of their area of residence within the Southland area.




