


15 Members Named To College Board

During and immediately following the Community Conference on Environmental Problems and Urban Design and Beautification held at the California State College, Dominguez Hills, participants expressed themselves orally to members of the college staff as to the effectiveness of the proceedings. The almost unanimous response was that the conference was one of the most successful they had attended in terms of lay-professional interaction. It was the general impression of the college staff that participants had a rewarding two days and, in particular, had come away with a much better awareness of the role which the college may play in helping communities in the area confront urban problems.

At a regional meeting of the American Institute of Planners on the Thursday following conclusion of the conference, many of the professional planners remarked that the conference had involved the college in matters of environmental design and urban planning in a promising fashion.

SOME WROTE personal letters to Dr. Cain. A Redondo Beach woman commented: "I appreciated the chance to hear the speakers with their varying viewpoints, the thinking of the professional planners in the discussion groups, and especially the vigor and enthusiasm of that fine faculty of yours." An Inglewood newspaper reporter sent personal congratulations and commented favorably about both the college and the content of the conference.

Two city managers from outside the college's service area remarked that the meeting had accomplished its goals. Mrs. Lyndon Johnson wrote that she was delighted to learn that the conference was a success.

AND THREE of the major speakers recorded their impressions in personal letters. Ray Hebert of the Los Angeles Times found the sessions "very interesting and enjoyable"

SACRAMENTO — Governor Ronald Reagan has announced the appointment of 15 members to the newly formed Board of Governors of California Community Colleges.

The new board members will choose their terms by lot, with four terms expiring in one year, four in two years, four in three years, and three in four years. The members also will elect their own president and vice president.

Appointments to the new board included: Herbert T. Stoschein, 59, Santa Ana dentist, a Republican and a member of the Santa Ana Unified and Junior College District Trustees for 10 years.

Charles R. Smoot, 52, Sherman Oaks general building contractor, Republican and former member of the Los Angeles City Board of Education.

Mrs. Winifred H. Lancaster, Republican, and trustee of the Santa Barbara Junior College District. She is a psychology and speech teacher.

Benjamin N. Scott, 38, Democrat of San Pedro, twice appointed to the State Board of Education, in 1961 and 1965. He retired from the state board to accept this appointment.

Harmon K. Howard, 52, vice president of Howard Shipping Terminal in Oakland, Republican, and a trustee of Contra Costa Junior College.

James C. Dodd, 45, Sacramento architect, Republican and member of the Sacramento Educational Resources Agency Advisory Council.
