



**PATROL CAPTAIN SAYS:**

**Even 'Dune Buggy' Must Meet the Law**

A motor vehicle by any other name—even "dune buggy" is a motor vehicle, and must be equipped to meet the standards set by the California Vehicle Code. According to California Highway Patrol Captain P. J. Ford of South Los Angeles Area, this fact is often forgotten or not understood by hobbyists who build special motor vehicles, either from supplied kits or from parts of other vehicles, and then seek to register them.

"Dune buggy builders often find they are unable to register their special new vehicles because they have left off certain pieces of essential equipment required by law," said the captain. "They would be well advised to find out ahead of time what equipment is needed and what equipment is legally required, then get it on the vehicle while they are building it. Any Highway Patrol Office has lists of required equipment and would be happy to assist them."
