Reagan Plan Calls For Four Agencies

 SACRAMENTO—Governor Ronald Reagan has presented a plan to the legislature to reorganize the executive branch of state government into four super agencies. Under legislation approved last year, the legislature may not make any changes in the governor's plan. The lawmakers may veto the proposal but, if no action is taken, this amounts to approval and the plan could take effect. Generally, the plan sets up four agencies—business and transportation, resources, human relations and agriculture and services. The only part of the government not included is the department of finance. Finance would retain an independent status and actually operate as an arm of the governor's office. A number of functions now in the governor's office, such as the consumer counsel, economic development agency and office of tourism and visitor services, would be transferred out of that office into the agencies.

Under the plan, the heads of the agencies would be known as secretaries, rather than administrators. The reorganization plan actually has been in effect for all practical purposes, on an unofficial basis. "In essence, this organization has been tried," Reagan said. "It works. It works well. It has been a most important first step toward the goals of effective, efficient and economic state government; goals which we all endorse."

REAGAN SAID he believed the plan would provide the maximum effectiveness at a minimum cost to the public. In 1961, Governor Edmund G. Brown effected the first major overhaul of the state governmental structure in many years. The legislature authorized setting up four agencies and Brown set up four more by executive order. At that time, there was considerable controversy about including the department of agriculture with any other agency and it was left independent.

Reagan had criticized the agency structure during the campaign. Since then, he has tended to bring the departments into even a more compact structure. The four agency heads he set up by executive order have formed his cabinet, along with the director of finance. The Business and Transportation Agency will include the departments of aeronautics, California Highway Patrol, motor vehicles, public works, banking, corporations, housing and community development, insurance, real estate, and savings and loan.

THE RESOURCES Agency will include the departments of conservation, fish and game, harbors and watercraft, parks and recreation, water resources, air resources board, Colorado River Board, the state water resources control board. This is essentially the same as the existing resources agency. The agency also will include the office of nuclear energy, which replaces the office of atomic energy development and radiation protection.

The Human Relations Agency will include the departments of corrections, mental hygiene, youth authority, public health, health care services, rehabilitation, social welfare, employment, industrial relations, and human resources development, a new department proposed by Reagan.

This agency also will include the service center program, the California commission on aging and the state advisory commission in Indian affairs.

THE AGRICULTURE and Services Agency will include the departments of agriculture, general services, professional and vocational standards, veterans affairs and the new department of commerce and the public employees' retirement system, state teachers' retirement system, franchise tax board, and state fire marshal.

The proposal does not include a revenue department, which had been part of a number of previous reorganization proposals. The Department of Commerce will include the division of economic development, museum of science and industry, San Francisco port authority, office of tourism and visitor services, California world trade coordinating council, San Francisco world trade authority and Southern California world trade authority.
