Missionary To Speak At Church

Dr. Charles Wical, a missionary doctor who has spent the past five years in Rhodesia and Tanzania, will speak at the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church Friday at 7:30 p.m. and Saturday at 9:30 a.m.

Dr. Wical and his family are in the United States on a two-year leave from their African work. He will attend Loma Linda University during the next two years to study anesthesiology.

During their stay in Africa, Dr. Wical and his family spent 18 months in Tanzania and some 3 1/2 years at the Yuka Mission Station in Rhodesia. The station has a 65-bed hospital and a leper compound and is located in the area inhabited by the Bimi and Lozi tribes.

Dr. Wical will discuss his experiences in Africa at the Friday evening service. He will talk with members of the Sabbath School Saturday morning.
