# Venereal Disease Topic Of Youth Council Meet

Between March 1 and March 11, South High students are selling discount ticket booklets for Operation Nepal. The children's booklet (for those in the eighth grade and under) sells for \$1, but has a \$1.40 value; the adult booklets have a \$2 value, but sell for \$1.50 this week only. These booklets include tickets for admission, food, rides, and entertainment.

As an incentive to Spartans to sell these booklets, a contest is being staged until the 11th. First prize, awarded to the seller of the most tickets, is \$50, two \$4.50 tickets to the Standell's concert, and being named "Boss of Operation Nepal"—with all rides free. Second prize is \$30 and two concert tickets, and third prize is \$20 and concert tick-

ets. Any Spartan who sells at least 10 booklets will at some later date be released from class to see a selected movie; the names of these students will be entered for a drawing of a \$50 grand prize.

The junior class is selling tickets to the Lakers vs. the Baltimore Bullets game March 10. It will be "South Night" at The Forum, and the ticket prices are \$3.50, 2/\$5, or \$1.50 if accompanied by a person over 18. The class gets 50 per cent of all the money from tickets sold.

Voting for the Cotten Ball Court was yesterday. Each class elects a princess, and the junior and senior classes select the queen to reign over this annual event—scheduled for March 29.

The truth about venereal disease was revealed to members of the Youth Council of Torrance when Mrs. Ruth Calloway of the County Health Department spoke at the council's last meeting.

Students learned that two area people died needlessly of syphilis in the past year. Mrs. Calloway also pointed out that the number of reported cases has nearly doubled in this same time period. Also discussed were the symptoms, characteristics, causes, and cures of both syphilis and gonorrhea.

The students suggested the following possible solutions to the problem of public ignorance about venereal disease: 1. Establish night classes for adults so that parents can enlighten their children on the subject.

2. Organize lecture-discussion groups for parents and young people to break down the barrier of embarrassment. The council also endorsed a program of clinical treatment for VD without parental knowledge for those 18 years and older. At present, a person must be 21 years of age in order to receive treatment without the consent of a parent.

Next Youth Council meeting is scheduled for March 20.





