

Delegates Listed for Kennedy

SACRAMENTO — A slate of delegates for Senator Robert F. Kennedy to be on the June 4 primary election ballot has been filed with Secretary of State Frank M. Jordan.

The delegation, headed by Assembly Speaker Jesse M. Unruh (D-Inglewood), includes the names of to Congressmen — Thomas M. Rees (D-Los Angeles) and Phillip Burton (D-San Francisco). It includes four state senators — George R. Moscone, Alan Short,

James R. Mills, and Mervyn Dymally — and 12 assemblymen.
 In addition, the list includes the names of the wives of several legislators, as well as other notables, in hopes that their husbands may be able to transfer from other delegations — those to President Lyndon B. Johnson and Senator Eugene J. McCarthy (D-Wisconsin).

The list includes such others as Gary J. Beban, the outstanding quarterback from UCLA; Elizabeth Smith Galtov, former U.S. treasurer;

Rafer Johnson, former Olympic star and now sports commentator; Joseph I. Kelly Jr., son-in-law of former Governor Edmund G. Brown; Mrs. Stanley Mock, wife of the State Supreme Court Justice; Howard Andrew Williams, more commonly known as Andy Williams; Mrs. Ruth Berle, wife of the comedian; actress Shirley MacLaine; Cesar Chavez, farm labor leader of Delano; and Thomas W. Braden, former president of the State Board of Education.


