Adventists Aid Church In Spain

For the first time, Torrance Seventh-day Adventists are contributing money to help build Adventist churches and chapels in Spain.

Spain passed a religious liberty law in 1967 but there are still restrictions, according to Mahlon Gilbert, leader of the local Sabbath school.

Gilbert said this makes it necessary to build and have authorized a new chapel if the church wishes to witness to persons in a section where there is no chapel.

The religious liberty law, however, now allows Adventist and other Protestant churches to look like and be identified as churches, Gilbert continued.

The Adventist church in Spain, organized in 1903, now has 21 organized congregations, embracing about 10 per cent of Spain's 30,000 Protestants.
