Freeway Callboxes Pass Assembly by 65-0 Vote

Assembly Bill 243 which was introduced by Assemblyman L. E. (Larry) Townsend (D-67th District) has passed the Assembly by a 65-0 vote. The legislation provides state funding of a program to provide emergency telephone communications on State freeways.

Townsend noted that a pilot system of 80 such emergency phones were installed in the Los Angeles area in 1965. "That system," he said, "was enormously successful. In the first year of operation it provided a means by which 8,099 emergency calls were placed to authorities by freeway users in need of help. "The pilot system," said Townsend, "has proved its value many times over, especially by adding to freeway safety and speeding assistance in accident cases. But it also avoided much inconvenience to luckless motorists experiencing minor difficulties. "The county of Los Angeles was so impressed with the need for this service to freeway users, it recently approved a county-wide system which was started in 1967. "But," added Townsend, "it is unfair to ask local governments to provide this service


