## '68 County Fair 'For the Birds'

More than \$8,000 in prize money will be for the birds, at the 41st annual Los Angeles County Fair.

The birds, 3,000 prize chickens, turkeys, ducks and geese, will be on exhibit in the fair's poultry department Sept. 24-29. Fair dates are Sept. 13 through 29.

One of 17 areas of competition offered by the fair, the poultry division provides classes or all breeds and varieties listed in the latest edition of the American Standard of Perfection, 15 in all.

Included in the 15 are 12 classes of chickens: American, Asiatic, English, Mediterranean, Hamburgs, Continental, Polish, French, Old English, Orientals, Bantams and a miscellaneous section, plus classes for turkeys, ducks and geese.

All rules for the show will be those of the American Poultry Association. Show judges, all members of the association, include: W. F. Fetterly, Phoenix, Arizona; Allen D. Fitchett, Cushing, Oklahoma; Dave B. Sherrill Jr., Arlington, Texas; and John Thomforde, Crockston, Minnesota. Judging begins at 8 a.m. Sept. 25.

Closing date for show entries is Saturday, Sept. 7. Birds must be at the fair by 10 a.m. Sept. 24. Show closes Sunday, Sept. 29.

The largest county fair in the nation, the Pomona exposition will host over a million visitors during its 17-day run.
