(Continued from Page 1) after a route is selected to work out the best possible routes near the affected schools.

Bert M. Lynn told his colleagues he opposed the "red route," the easternmost of the proposed routes. Trustees generally expressed agreement with Lynn on that point.

The red route favored by Redondo Beach would pass through the North Redondo area between the San Diego Freeway and 190th Street near the city's eastern boundary.

BOTH the green and blue routes, however, would virtually cut the North Redondo area off from the rest of the city, it was noted.

Petitions opposing all three north-south routes are being circulated in the West Torrance area. In addition, North Redondo residents have promised to circulate petitions calling for adoption of the red route.

A hearing before the State Highway Department is scheduled Oct. 10 at Torrance High School. The department is expected to make its recommendation for a route following that hearing.

Later in the meeting, Sciarrotta commented that the city currently owns many sunpits which will someday be available for small, neighborhood parks when they are no longer needed as sunpits.
