This is "LEAVE THE CAR AT HOME AND RIDE THE BUS TO WORK" week. I know it's that week because I invented it. Not only that, but next week will be "WHY DIDN'T I DO THIS A LONG TIME AGO?" week. When you realize that hundreds of people drive downtown and pay enough in parking fees to more than buy a monthly pass, added to the parking and traffic, dented fenders, etc., plus increased insurance and you can begin to see how practical the bus could be. One monthly pass can save you a bundle of money. Take a little something home to the wife this week—a bus.

Responding to the many "Why don't they?" requests, let me acquaint you with your bus system. I say your, because the Southern California Rapid Transit System is a public corporation created by the Legislature in 1958 to do two jobs. The first was to buy the three existing local bus companies and operate them; second, to plan, engineer and build a modern Rapid Transit system. The RTD is doing both these jobs in an efficient business-like manner. The buses are run entirely from the money you drop into the fare box. Unlike other cities with large public subsidies, the RTD does not receive one penny from any outside source. There is a formula that fits the situation to a tee, and that is "the more people ride, the better the service will be." The Transit District is a business, the bus service is the product and you are the customer. The more of the product you buy, the better product the company can offer.

Summer is half gone. Have you seen all the places you wanted to? The Southland is a fascinating place, to say the least, and much of it can be seen by bus. RTD is going to these interesting places every day of the week, so why don't you go, too? Send for a map of the system, plus one of the new do-it-yourself tour guides today.

A. The 103 line at Fonthill & Segundo Boulevard will take you to Hawthorne Boulevard where you can change to the 5 line to Union Station.

Q. Please tell me about the new line from Rolling Hills to Los Angeles. I live in Lomita and could use it if it fits my time. Mr. O.T.

A. Like Rudy Valle used to sing, "Your Time Is My Time," the 125 line has 5 trips in the a.m. starting at 5:35 from Rolling Hills, with trips following at 6:00, 6:25, 6:55 and 7:30. I'll send you a timetable and a map.

Q. Having been to Marineland, we now want to go to Knott's and Disneyland. How would we get there from Inglewood? We are within walking distance of downtown Inglewood. Mrs. C.L.J.

A. My advise would be to pick either Knott's or Disneyland for your trip. You can't do both justice in one day. Catch the 5 line on Market, ride to 6th and Broadway, walk 3 blocks east to the terminal and catch the 58 line to Knott's or Disneyland. I'll send you a map and timetables.

Q. What is the best way to get to downtown Los Angeles from Torrance, around Torrance Boulevard? T.L.

A. Catch the Torrance Municipal #1 line on Carson and Vermont. RTD does not operate in that area.
