

## URGES YOU TO DRIVE SAFELY THIS HOLIDAY SEASON






The California Highway Patrol and the Torrance Police Department can only help you if you help yourself. Don't challenge other cars—challenge yourself to be an expert, law-abiding driver! That could assure you that you and your family can enjoy a safe holiday. Through July 528 persons have been injured in 355 traffic accidents in Torrance—three have been killed. Don't add to the terrible statistic.



**3 DEAD!** Car ran off roadway, struck bridge abutment. A careless moment coupled with a speeding vehicle and such tragedies come all too often on long weekends such as the upcoming Labor Day weekend.



**4 DEAD!** In this head-on collision, one vehicle was on the wrong side of the roadway. During the coming holiday weekend, a regard for traffic laws and the other fellow can prevent most accidents. Such regard for driving safety should be a daily habit.



**5 DEAD!** In this head-on smash-up on a high-speed overpass, one vehicle crossed the divider on a curve. The economic loss of accidents like this just in Los Angeles County each year runs into millions of dollars—and no price can include the cost of a life.
