

25 Liquor Licenses Available

SACRAMENTO — The state Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control today announced 159 new on-sale and 87 new off-sale liquor licenses will be available in 13 California counties because of increases in population.

The department will accept priority applications for the licenses from Sept. 16 to Sept. 30, Edward J. Kirby, director stated.

New original licenses are issued by the state for a fee of \$6,000, and a state fee of \$3,000 is charged on each inter-county transfer.

Kirby said that after Sept. 30, if more applicants have filed than there are licenses available, a public drawing will be held. Only one priority application for each available type of licenses will be accepted from any one applicant.

Twenty-five on-sale licenses are available in Los Angeles County.

(Continued from Page 1) illustrated my point," Wilson said, "by saying that two of his people have already attempted to apprehend burglary suspects. One of these people still has a fractured jaw!"

In addition to the community area patrol, the homeowners group has outlined an extensive crime control program. The group plans to sell brochures listing the various articles normally found in a home with an adjacent blank for writing in the item's serial number.

HOMEOWNERS will be encouraged to mark those articles which have no serial numbers and take color photographs of furniture and other valuables.

Members have been urged to notify police if they observe unruly gatherings, strange cars in driveways, or other suspicious occurrences. They will also be encouraged to turn on more lights to discourage criminals.

Elephant Rides Ruled Part of 'Petting Zoo'

Elephant and camel rides were ruled to be an integral part of a children's "petting zoo" Tuesday night by city councilmen.

The decision came after Movieland Productions representative Bill Becker told councilmen that city licensing fees for the traveling zoo were too steep.

Becker complained that the city wanted to charge his company \$6 per day for the petting zoo and an additional sum for a permit to conduct elephant and camel

rides, on the grounds that animals provided "entertainment rides."

Councilmen voted to permit the petting zoo and rides for the \$6 daily fee.

The animal carnival will appear Sept. 10 at the Torrance White Front parking lot. Goats, llamas, baby elephants, and other small, tame creatures will be available for children to pet.

Becker said his company has purchased \$1/2 million worth of insurance to cover the event.
