

Schools will be open for the Fall semester soon. California Highway Patrol Commissioner H. W. Sullivan suggests that this is an appropriate time for the entire family to review certain sections of the vehicle code. "There's something for everyone of kindergarten age or older," he said.

For the drivers in the family:

- The speed limit is 25 miles per hour when passing a school building or school grounds while children are going to or from school during opening or closing hours and during the noon recess period. The same limit applies when passing any school grounds which are not separated from the highway by a fence at any time the grounds are in use by children and the highway is posted with a "SCHOOL" warning sign.

- The driver of any vehicle which meets or overtakes from either direction any school bus which has stopped to pick up or discharge any children and which is displaying a flashing red light signal visible front and rear must stop immediately before passing the bus and may not proceed until the flashing signal ceases operation. It is not necessary to stop when passing a stopped school bus at an intersection where traffic is controlled by a traffic officer or official traffic control signal, or when the school bus is in the opposite lane on a divided highway.

- Remember pedestrians have the right of way while crossing the roadway within any marked crosswalk or within any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection.

- Follow directions of school crossing guards and junior traffic patrols.

For the bicycle riders in the family:

- Every person riding a bicycle upon a roadway has all the rights and duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle, under the Vehicle Code, except those provisions which, by their nature, cannot apply.

- It is unlawful to operate a bicycle on a roadway unless it is equipped with a brake which will enable the operator to make one braked wheel skid on dry, level, clean pavement.

- It is illegal to ride a bicycle equipped with handlebars which raise the operator's hands above the level of his shoulders.

- The pedals of the bicycle may not, in the lowermost position, be more than

12 inches above the ground. After darkness, every bicycle on the road must be equipped with a lamp emitting a white light visible from 300 feet in front of the bicycle and with a red reflector on the rear visible from 300 feet to the rear when directly in front of upper beams of automobile

headlamps. A lamp emitting a red light visible from 300 feet to the rear may be used in addition to the reflector. Bicyclists must ride as near the right side of the roadway as practicable, exercising care when passing a standing vehicle or one proceeding in the same direction.

- It is illegal for a person on a bike to hitch himself to any vehicle on the roadway.
- It is illegal to allow anyone to ride on the handlebars.
- It is illegal to carry any package or bundle or books, while riding a bicycle, that

prevent the bicyclist from keeping at least one hand on the handlebars. For the school bus riders: The school bus driver has full authority over school bus riders in the bus and when the pupils are leaving the bus and being escorted across the street. No one is allowed to

stand while riding a school bus. For young pedestrians: Cross the road in crosswalks. Obey the crossing guards. Obey traffic signals. Red means stop — don't cross. Yellow means wait — don't cross. Green means go!
