

## Lectures Slated at Bullock's

"Tension Areas: The World Today," a program of daytime lectures for the general public, will start Tuesday, Oct. 1, 9:30 to 11 a.m., in La Casita Community Building, Bullock's Del Amo, Fashion Square, according to a UCLA Extension official.

In a series of eight weekly lectures, educators and research authorities will deal with questions related to this country's role in Southeast Asia, the continuing arms race, the Alliance for Progress, Chinese expansion, Soviet foreign policy, South Africa's racial conflict, and factors that determine U.S. foreign policy.

Enrollment is open for the series, or single admission tickets will be available at the door if space permits.

## Students Learn How To Handle Inflation

The problems of inflation plague school children as well as their parents. Members of the Educational Council of Torrance learned Monday at their regular luncheon meeting that youngsters involved in economics education programs at local schools deal with inflation in much the same way that the federal government does.

Narrating Monday's slide program were Ronald Hall and Richard Brown, principals of Arnold and Riviera elementary schools, where the educational experiment was carried out.

Hall and Brown said that pupils were called upon to set up their own model governments, issuing money and establishing a tax rate.

**HOW DID** the kids handle inflation? They raised income taxes and boosted bank interest rates, Hall and Brown explained.

The youngsters also organized their own corporations, mass producing such items as necklaces, paper weights, and "fuzzy wuzzies," trading among themselves and children from other participating schools.

Arnold school children printed up "Arnies" as a medium of exchange and Riviera pupils traded in "Rivets." Just as in adult society, the junior capitalists discovered that desire is unlimited while means are limited.

## Class in Gardening Scheduled

"Successful Home Gardening" is the name of the class slated to begin Thursday, Sept. 19, at South Coast Botanic Garden, 26701 Rolling Hills Road, Palos Verdes Peninsula.

Sponsored by the South Coast Botanic Foundation, the classes will be conducted from 9 a.m. to noon and 1 to 4 p.m. Each class will cover the same material.

Instructor for the new course will be Mrs. Lydia Birt Williams, horticulturist, teacher, nurserywoman, and garden consultant. Mrs. Williams said the course will be geared to solving the many problems faced by the homegardener in the South Bay area. Class members will be encouraged to bring individual problems to the meetings.

**THE CLASS** will cover a basic study of plant propagation, reviewing such methods as seeding, layering, and tip and root cuttings. Ideas for seasonal planting for color will include bulb plants.

Is the nursery counter a big mystery? The class will delve into which garden product is which, what they contain, how to buy and use them, and shopping for gardening materials.

The class will learn how to prune, trellis, bonsai, and espalier plants. Lawn and hillside planting and maintenance will be stressed.
