


Labor Committee Formed To Back Wallace Drive

Bob Walters, state coordinator for the Wallace campaign, has announced the formation of a "Labor for Wallace Committee."

Cleve Anno, a member of the Boilermakers' Union, will serve as state director, with Steve Czausz of the Teamsters' Union heading "Labor for Wallace" in Los Angeles County.

Both men are residents of Torrance working in the Wallace Campaign Headquarters located at 2111 Pacific Coast Hwy., Lomita. Office hours are 10 a.m. to 9 p.m.

The 300 members of the committee represent 97 unions, including Carpenters, UAW, Steelworkers, United Farm Workers, and the California Teachers As-

sociation. Conferences with many union leaders are now being arranged.

"George Wallace is and has been a union man. Labor Councils and various locals throughout Alabama have long supported him," Anno said.

"Every labor poll taken in recent months has repeatedly shown that vast numbers, indeed usually a majority, of union people throughout the nation support George Wallace and the cause he represents," he added.

Retiring Solon Backs Anderson for Congress


