

Beacon Street Project Topic of Area Meeting

A special public meeting to discuss the current status of San Pedro's Beacon Street Redevelopment Project will be held next Tuesday at 7:30 p.m. at Dana Junior High School, 1501 S. Cabrillo Avenue, San Pedro.

"The purpose of the meeting is to bring all interested citizens up to date on the study and planning regarding the Project," Ted Springfield, chairman of the San Pedro Community Development Advisory Committee, stated. "Our meeting is not just for residents and owners in the Project. It is also for members of the greater Los Angeles and San Pedro communities who likewise will benefit from redevelopment of the area."

A principal speaker at the meeting will be Los Angeles City Councilman John S. Gibson Jr., who represents the San Pedro area. Gibson has been a continuing supporter for the revitalization of the harbor community since civic leaders first began thinking about the rebuilding of Beacon Street in 1958.

The Beacon Street Project is one of several programs under the Community Redevelopment Agency of the city of Los Angeles. Agency officials, including Administrator Richard G. Mitchell,

will also be on hand at the meeting to discuss the future of Beacon Street. John Holland, Chairman of the Citizen Participation and Community Involvement Subcommittee of the Advisory Committee, will chair the meeting.

During the same period, the American Red Cross collected 196,757 pints of blood for hospitalized patients; conducted self-help training courses for 72,680 children and adults; answered 44,364 requests for assistance for families of service men and women; provided 20,269 trained volunteers for more than two million hours of service in medical facilities, children's homes, bloodmobiles, shelter care homes and American Red Cross centers.
