

Watt Named '68 Builder of Year

Ray A. Watt, one of the nation's leading home builders and community developers, has been named "Builder of the Year" by the Building Industry Association of California in recognition of his outstanding service to the community and the industry.

The award was presented by association president R. C. Gallyon and William Lyon, recipient of the award in 1967, at the organiza-

tion's annual convention in San Diego.

Sponsored by Southern California and Southern Counties Gas Cos., the builder-of-the-year award is a perpetual trophy given for outstanding service to the community as a citizen and as a building contractor.

IN THE last 21 years, Watt has built more than

30,000 homes, 5,000 apartments, 2,000 condominium units, 58 mobile home parks, and 5 million square feet of industrial space.

The R. A. Watt Co. now ranks as one of the country's most dynamic and fastest growing home builders and community developers. It builds home ranging in price from \$14,000 to \$65,000.

In December, 1967, the company became a wholly-

owned subsidiary of Boise Cascade Corp. and under Watt's direction launched a long range national home building program. Projects already have been started in New Jersey, Washington, and Northern California.

WATT pointed out that the housing industry is second only to the food and food processing industries in its impact on the American economy.

Widows Eligible For Funds

An estimated 15,000 California widows of veterans who have died as the result of military service will be eligible for up to 36 months of educational assistance from the Veterans Administration beginning Dec. 1, Mort Webster, manager of VA's Southern California regional office, said today.

He pointed out that starting Dec. 1, the wives of California's 10,600 totally and permanently disabled veterans will also be entitled to VA educational assistance payments of \$130 a month — up to a maximum

of 36 months—for full-time institutional training.

The allowance for three-quarters time training — quarters training is \$95 a month, with \$60 being paid for half-time training under the new law granting these widows and wives VA educational help for the first time in the history of veterans' benefits in the United States, Webster said.

Widows and wives now eligible for this benefit will have until Dec. 1, 1976, to complete their training under this new program, Webster explained.

He said that women who become eligible in the future for VA educational assistance due to the service-connected death or permanent and total disability of their husbands will have eight years to complete their training.

Eligibility of widows and wives does not depend on when their husbands served in the Armed Forces. However, he added, if a widow remarries or a wife divorces her disabled husband she loses her entitlement.
