

# USC Institute Explores Police-Teen Relations

Sensitive and often explosive relationships between youth and the police will be explored Dec. 12 at a University of Southern California conference at which Los Angeles Police Chief Tom Reddin and other high-level law enforcement professionals will be featured speakers.

Conducted under auspices of USC's Delinquency Control Institute, the conference will be held in conjunction with graduation exercises of the USC institute's 47th class.

The graduation will mark completion of a 12-week course

by 28 police officers and other professionals in youth work from across the nation.

**MEMBERS** of the class include Officer Ramon Schneider, juvenile investigator for the Torrance Police Department, and Detective Patrolman David Lawrenson of the Redondo Beach Police Department.

It is expected that between 200 and 250 police chiefs, city managers, and alumni of the Delinquency Control Institute from the southern California area will attend the conference

in Hancock Auditorium on the USC campus from 9:30 to 11:45 a.m.

The conference is designed to be a continuing education and refresher program for professionals concerned with law enforcement and youth, according to Dr. John D. Gerletti of South Pasadena, director of USC's Delinquency Control Institute.

**CHIEF REDDIN** will deliver the graduation address following luncheon in USC's Town and Gown; Tucson Police Chief Bernard Barmire will speak on "A

New Look at the School Resource Officer" at 9:30 a.m. Gerletti will speak on "DCI Today and Tomorrow; A Progress Report," at 10:30 a.m.

Graduation ceremonies for the class in which members will receive certificates, will follow Chief Reddin's speech in Town and Gown.

USC's Delinquency Control Institute program, which provides academic and practical training, is designed to help law enforcement officers and others work more effectively in the

handling of youth and its problems.

**THE GRADUATES** have received classroom instruction and have participated in seminar discussion in all areas of the subject, based on the latest in techniques and research.

The institute, which has operated continuously since 1946, is in session twice yearly — in the fall and spring semesters — and offers 12 units of college credit with USC's School of Public Administration.

# Sea Wall Unit Set By County

County supervisors have approved plans and specifications for another unit of the Dominguez Gap sea barrier project in the Wilmington area and issued a call for bids, Supervisor Burton W. Chace said today.

Estimated cost of the unit is placed at about \$400,000.

Contractors' offers will be opened Dec. 20 in the offices of the County Flood Control District. Award of the contract by supervisors is expected about 10 days later, Chace said.

**THE JOB** calls for installation of about two and one-half miles of water supply pipeline and approximately one mile of disposal line.

The supply line will provide water for recharge wells to help maintain a barrier against further sea water encroachment into fresh supplies, Chace said. Purpose of the disposal line is to remove dirty water when wells are flushed.

Site of the work lies generally within the boundaries of

Pacific Coast Highway on the north, the Harbor Freeway on the west, "B" Street on the south, and Alameda Street on the east.

**CHACE SAID** part of the project will take it past Hawaiian Avenue School and Hawaiian Avenue Child Care Center. During construction in this area, the contractor will be required to erect a temporary five-foot high chain link fence around the excavation.
