

Family Planning Clinic Set at Harbor General

Southern California's only Family Planning Clinic offering day and night service through a six-day week has been established at Harbor General Hospital, 1000 W. Carson St.

It is one of several Family Planning Clinics financed through the Los Angeles Regional Family Planning Council with funds provided by the Federal Office of Economic Opportunity.

The clinic is unique in that it is a "walk-in" service with doctors and nurses on duty from 9 a.m. to 9 p.m. Mondays through Fridays, and 10 a.m. to 3 p.m. Saturdays.

IN ADDITION to the medical staff, the clinic also offers the services of a community consultant on family planning problems. The latter will contact area organizations to explain the purpose of the clinic and enlist their aid in advising women to take advantage of the service.

At present there are no area boundary eligibility regulations and no appointments are necessary. However, the Family Planning Clinic is free only to those who are unable to afford private medical care.

The new Family Planning Clinic is housed in the same building at Harbor General in which the Pap Clinic is situated.

Auction Scheduled Jan. 25

The next regular auction is scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 22.

THE TWO clinics complement each other. For instance, the Pap tests which are given to detect early signs of cancer of the cervix, will continue to be available to all women free. These clinics are in building B-6, one of the original Army facilities recently remodeled and easily reached from the Carson Street entrance by following signs with arrows pointing to "Pap Clinic."

"The new Family Planning Clinic is a 'walk-in' operation," Dr. Daniel Mishell Jr., chief of obstetric-gynecology, said. "No appointments are required and the evening hours are designed to accommodate women who are unable to be examined and interviewed during the day because of home duties or job demands."

"ANOTHER factor," Dr. Mishell added, "is that the clinic offers women free choice of all medically approved contraceptive methods. Further, the purpose of the clinic will include screening the signs of the two most common cancers in women. These are breast cancer and cancer of the cervix."

There are more Family Planning Clinics in Los Angeles County, but they are not geared as extensively to permit the 65-hour a week service offer offered by the new facility at Harbor General Hospital.

"In fact," Dr. Mishell said, "it was to relieve the overburdened clinics that the new service was established here."
