Torrance Man Gets Top Air Force Post

Col. William K. Bailey has been named the new director of development engineering at Air Force Contract Management Division (AFCMD) in Westchester, Maj. Gen. D. E. Riley, AFCMD commander has announced.

Colonel Bailey, a veteran of more than 25 years of military service, will be responsible for Air Force development engineering activities in AFCMD detachments scattered across the nation, and will be involved with such programs as the C-5 and F-111 aircraft, and Minuteman III ICBM.

RESponsible for administering contracts with a combined face value of more than \$45 billion, AFCMD has detachments located in major industrial centers across the country. In addition to managing contracts for the Air Force, AFCMD also serves the Army, Navy, NASA and other government agencies.

Colonel Bailey is a veteran officer in Air Force research and development activities, having been formerly assigned to the Atlas/Advanced Ballistic Re-Entry Systems Project Office at Vandenberg AFB, Calif.

A VETERAN combat pilot, Colonel Bailey comes to AFCMD after serving as commander of the 311th Special Operations Squadron at Phan Rang Air Base in Vietnam, where he flew 822 combat sorties in the C-123 aircraft. He also served in the Korean War, accumulating 139 combat hours during 25 missions in C-54 aircraft.

Colonel Bailey earned a BS degree from the University of Wyoming through the Air Force Institute of Technology in 1963 and is a graduate of the Air War College at Maxwell AFB, Ala.

Born in Kosciusko, Miss., Colonel Bailey is married and has two children. He and his family are currently living at 3555 Sara Drive.
