Highways Division Sets Sale

The California Division of Highways has announced the pending auction sale of one of the largest and most valuable parcels of surplus land ever offered by its property disposal section.

The approximately 46 acres of residentially zoned land is located between the San Diego Freeway and Bolsa Chica Road, north of the Vallecito Avenue, within the city limits of Westminster.

The parcel is level and at grade with existing streets. It is suitable for residential lots and is in an area presently zoned R-1-10000, although the city zoning administrator has indicated that zone R-1-6500 would be compatible with adjoining developments.

The minimum acceptable bid for the property is \$1 million. The successful bidder will be required to deposit \$100,000 at the time of sale. The balance of the amount bid will be due Sept. 18, 1970.

The public auction sale is scheduled for 10 a.m. March 18, in Room 2, Division of Highways Building, 120 S. Spring St., Los Angeles.
