What to do in an emergency? Too often when called upon to assist a person in distress, most of us do not know how to meet the challenge. General Telephone Co. of California hopes to do something about this.

Continuing through March, all employees of the utility's South Bay division will be given five separate lessons concerning medical self help training, announced Bodie Fite, South Bay division manager.

The purposes of "Medical Self Help" are to provide employees with knowledge and skills in treating injuries and caring for the sick in emergency situations.

"The likelihood of being called upon to render assistance increases all the time in today's society," Fite said. "It is hoped that employees will be able to help others, or themselves, as a

result of knowledge gained through this program." Included in the five presentations will be instructions on artificial respiration, bleeding and bandaging, fractures and splinting, burns, and shock.

PPG Plant To Install Computers

PPG Industries, Inc. (former Pittsburgh Plate Glass Co.) has ordered six Pasadena-made Burroughs Corp. B2500 electronic computer systems valued at \$3.2 million for use in six plants of its Coating and Resins Division, including one in Torrance.

The Burroughs computers will handle standardized application

programs serving all the accounting, production, distribution, and marketing functions of the division's six trade paint plants, 19 distribution centers, 400 company-owned paint centers, as well as sales to several thousand dealers in the U.S.

In addition to the Torrance plant computer, the other Bur-

roughs systems will be installed at PPG facilities in Springdale, PA.; Milwaukee, Wis.; Houston, Tex.; East Point, Ga., and Newark, N.J.

Magnetic tape units and disc file memory for each computer will be produced at Burroughs' new Westlake Village facility near Thousand Oaks.
