## Friday Films Slated

Eleven entertaining films for people of all ages will be presented by the Torrance Recreation Department Friday nights during the month of March from 7:30 to 10 p.m. at the Joslyn Center.

"The Middle East," a film which portrays 4,000 years of history from the early cultures of the region to the current aspects of the shifting area, will be shown along with three other films this Friday. "The American Vision" which scans American paintings from the late 18th to the early 20th centuries and "Celebration," a film which portrays Canada's many moods and costumes will also be featured.

The last film to be shown on this date will be "Upper Canada Village" which portrays life of a community founded on the banks of the St. Lawrence River a century ago.

THREE films, including "I Am a Soldier," which focuses on the daily activities of the Eighth Cavalry 1st Battalion's A Company as they train, go on routine operations, and fight in "search and destroy" missions will be shown March 14.

"Madeline's Rescue," a story about a orphan girl in Paris and "Bluefin Rodeo" which takes the audience to the sea to witness the annual International Tuna Cup Match held in Nova Scotia also will be presented.

"Major Religions of the World" which focuses on the origin, growth, and influence of Hinduism, Buddhism, Judaism, Christianity, and Islamism and "Ski B.C." a film which shows skiing in British Columbia will be featured March 21.

OTHER films which will be shown on the same night are "Aspen: Winter Mood," portraying life at one of the ski capitals of the world and "Alexander and the Car with the Missing Headlight," a film which was produced by animating children's drawings to create an imaginative tale.

"Michelangelo: The Last Giant" will be shown March 28 in cooperation with the Los Angeles County Museum of Natural History. The film portrays the life and works of the Florentine artist of the Renaissance and will be presented during the "Art in Recreation Exhibit" also to be held at 7:30 p.m. at the Joslyn Center.

THE GROUP is participating in a community-wide effort to raise money to pay Pam's staggering medical bills. Pam has been hospitalized since the accident with severe burns and broken bones. Her total bills so far have been estimated at \$25,000 and she still faces months of therapy and treatment. Insurance will cover only a small portion of the bill.

According to businessmen sponsoring the fund-raising drive for Pam, roughly \$6,000 has been gathered into a special fund at Imperial Bank. The fund includes the benefit donations of the Symbols of Tyme, Chapel Theatre Group, civic organizations, and friends.

BUSINESSMEN are asking local citizens to purchase tickets for \$1 at area shops bearing the "For Pam" posters. A lucky ticket-holder will win a color television set. Proceeds of this drive have not been completely tallied yet.

Pam is the daughter of Police Lieutenant and Mrs. Mickey Fischer of Torrance.

## Tax Forms Sent Out In Error

County Assessor Phil Watson reported today that approximately 40,000 application forms for the new \$750 property tax exemption were mailed erroneously covering vacant parcels of land.

Owners of vacant lots who receive the forms printed with the vacant lot descriptions should disregard the applications. They need not be returned to the Assessor's office.

Of the 1,650,000 forms mailed, these 40,000 were included due to a computer programming error, Watson explained.
