Temporary Gas Tax Hike Eyed

SACRAMENTO — Californians may face a "short-term" gasoline tax increase, with Gov. Ronald Reagan's blessing, to help pay the more than \$65 million in damage caused by recent storms and flooding throughout the state.

Reagan, in a message to Senate President Pro Tempore Hugh Burns and Assembly Speaker Bob Monagan, has called for a meeting of the two leaders of the Legislature and the governor, Monday, to "to consider the need for a short-term gas tax measure as a way to meet the emergency of the current flood disaster problem."

The governor said, "The disaster damage to California streets and highways is now mounting as the storms continue to take their toll. This damage is reaching proportions where existing state and local highway funds may not be adequate to provide the necessary relief."

"Statewide totals are now estimated at \$65 million with additional storms forecast. At the present time we anticipate an estimated \$17 million may be available from federal sources."
