A. This would be the 125 line providing flyer service to Los Angeles. Some trips go through Redondo Beach and Hermosa Beach, while others use the Harbor Freeway. I have sent you a timetable for this line.

Q. Can I transfer from a Gardena local line to an RTD line to go to downtown Los Angeles? Mr. A.V.

A. Transfers are not issued between Gardena local and RTD Buses, but Gardena has a line into Los Angeles. The local 1 bus line goes to Sixth and Main Streets in Los Angeles.

Q. How late can we get a bus from the Sports Arena area to El Segundo? We want to attend a basketball game there. Mr. R.B.

A. The last schedule leaves Los Angeles at 12:30 a.m. and arrives in El Segundo at 1:20 a.m. This should be late enough for most games.
