

Two Bills Signed by Governor

Gov. Ronald Reagan has signed into law two bills authored by Assemblyman Robert G. Beverly (R-Manhattan Beach) to permit a subpoenaed witness to appear in court at other than the specified time and to permit the question of damages in an injunctive action to be determined in the main action.

Both bills are aimed at improving the administration of justice and were endorsed by the State Bar of California. They will become effective 61 days after adjournment of the current session.

One measure, AB 417, provides a procedure whereby any person posting security in an action for an injunction or restraining order places himself under the jurisdiction of the court in such action with respect to liability on the security, in the event it is determined that the injunction should not have been issued.

"UNDER present law," Beverly said, "in the event the injunction is determined to be improperly issued, and damages are suffered, the injured party must bring a separate suit to recover for the damages. This measure would permit the question of damages to be determined in the main action."

The second bill, AB 416, permits a witness subpoenaed to appear in court to arrange with the person who issued the subpoena to appear at a time other than that specified.

BEVERLY said this new law was designed to accommodate witnesses and to avoid situations where they must spend long periods of time in the courtroom awaiting a call to the witness stand.

"Attorneys have made agreements with witnesses for appearance at a time other than specified in the subpoena for years," Beverly said, "and the bill merely grants statutory authority for such a practice."

Showcase Recital Scheduled

A "Showcase Recital" by soloists of the society will be presented on Sunday at 3 p.m. at the First United Methodist Church in Los Angeles.

An Oratorio workshop series will be presented at the church on Thursday evenings in August at 7:30 p.m., with guest conductors leading the reading and study sessions.

On Nov. 23 Handel's "Messiah" will be produced with guest soloists, selected by audition. The spring presentation will feature the Oratorio "St. Paul" by Mendelssohn.

Modification of Traffic Signal In Area Slated

Bids for the modification of traffic signals and highway lighting in Redondo Beach have been advertised by the State Department of Public Works.

Work will involve signals at Torrance Boulevard and Pacific Coast Highway. It will be coupled with the installation of a signal system at Pacific Coast Highway and 21st Street in Hermosa Beach.

Some \$29,500 is available for the project and bids will be opened July 3 in Los Angeles.
