

American Legion Sets Fireworks Exhibition

An hour-long program of the most impressive and beautiful fireworks ever seen anywhere, including the Los Angeles Coliseum, will be the major feature and the climax of the 37th annual American Legion 4th of July Thrillorama (West Berlin Circus) and fireworks spectacular in the coliseum, according to Hugh Wilson, commander of the legion's Los Angeles county council.

"In addition to the many hundreds of aerial bombs which will burst in colorful profusion high over the coliseum, magnificent set pieces in varied rainbow hues will cover the gridiron," Wilson said. "Some of them will be almost 100 feet in length."

Among the huge set-piece scenes to be depicted will be the United Crusade emblem, symbolizing the show theme, "A Salute to the United Crusade," a tribute to youth baseball, the Statue of Liberty and a truly brilliant action production in fireworks recreating the naval bombardment during the invasion of Normandy.

Aerial shell-bursts will symbolize cherry blossoms, rainbow umbrellas, chrysums, molten snow drops, fireflies and moonbeams. "Climaxing the entire affair will be a conglomeration of aerial skybursts," according to Wilson.

"Close to a thousand aerial bursts will occur within a period of five minutes. They will include hundreds of the largest and most spectacular fireworks shells imported from all parts of the world," he said.

At College Recreation Events Set

A summer-long recreation and community service program will begin Monday, June 23, at Los Angeles Harbor College.

The program will combine an active recreational program with special classes, musical programs and films under the direction of Robert Myers, community services coordinator.

The softball fields, tennis courts, football field, track, gymnasium, archery range and body-building room will all be open for use. League and individual activities will be featured in basketball, gymnastics, volleyball, softball and soccer. There will be a high school and a junior college league operating in basketball.

UNDER THE auspices of the community services program the facilities will be open week days from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. Harbor College coaches Jim White and Verne Kelsey will supervise the athletic activities with Bob Myers arranging special programs on the cultural side.

TWO SPECIAL activities under the direction of members

of the regular faculty are also on the schedule. Starting July 7 and continuing for four weeks Mrs. Marilyn Brock of the Home Economics and Nursery School Education Department will conduct a pre-school educational workshop from 9 to 10, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday for mothers of children from three to five.

Using the facilities of the women's gymnasium there will be planned activities and instructions for both the parents and children. Mrs. Brock will be assisted by students in the nursery school education courses at the college.

There is no charge and no registration procedure for the course. Parents interested may obtain further information by phoning Harbor College.

FOR THOSE artistically inclined, art instructor Jon Grider has prepared a special course starting July 7 and running for six weeks involving the techniques of drawing, painting and photography.

He is using an original approach to stimulate the creativity of the students. Class hours are from 6:30 to 9:30 Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday.

Both courses are non-credit courses presented as special community service activities. They are not part of the school's regular curriculum.


