

Emergency Number Endorsed

At the request of Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, county supervisors have endorsed a proposal in Congress to make the telephone number 911 an emergency number throughout the United States for police, fire and ambulance service.

Hahn has been leading a vigorous campaign for several years toward developing an easily remembered number which could be dialed by persons needing help from any police or fire jurisdiction.

"Allocating the number 911 on a nationwide basis is an important step toward a national emergency telephone system," Hahn said after the board endorsed House Resolution 10413.

Under the present system, a citizen may dial "0" for operator and, if he knows his location, the jurisdiction involved and the type of service he needs, he will be transferred.

"A single emergency number would result in immediate communications with emergency services and could save many lives," Hahn said.

Hahn became interested in emergency telephone aids when he led a 15-year effort to install the Freeway Call Box System on Los Angeles County Freeways.

Business Courses Offered

Business courses offered by Harbor College during the July 1-Aug. 11 summer session include a variety of subjects offered for job preparation and personal use according to Robert Wrenn, chairman of the college's business division.

Three levels of typewriting including personal typewriting (Secretarial 60), and a shorthand review class are in the evening schedule.

Day classes include bookkeeping and accounting, business data processing, business English, introduction to office machines, business law, rotary calculators, business computations, and the three levels of typewriting.

Daytime registration hours run from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Friday, June 23 through 27, as well as Monday, June 30. Evening registration hours run from 6 to 8 p.m.

Registration is open to high school graduates and persons 18 years of age or older who are residents of the Los Angeles Junior College District. Registration is accomplished in one step with no permit request or entrance tests required. Further information may be obtained by phoning Harbor College.

Homeowner Refunds Processed

County Assessor Phil Watson announced today that the state controller is in the process of mailing \$70 tax refund checks to homeowners in Los Angeles County from a list of 730,000 claimants submitted to the controller.

However, there are another 120,000 applications requiring special processing that have yet to be submitted to the controller, Watson explained, adding:

"If a homeowner is eligible for the 1968 refund and has not received his check, he will be listed on the supplemental list and receive a refund at a later date.

"We estimate that the refund will be essentially completed by mid-July, and if anyone who filed for the refund has not heard from the state controller by that time, he should contact my office."
