Adventists Collect Funds For Hospital In Africa

Would you trade a gymnasium for a hospital? That's what the Torrance Seventh-day Adventist Church would do — if it had one.

The church has received a report from missionary Doctor Kenneth H. Sturdevant of Kendu Mission Hospital urging modern-

ization of present facilities. "The money required to build a single college gymnasium on the campus of our schools in the United States would rebuild Kendu Hospital," he says.

THE KENDU Hospital, opened in 1924 at Kendu Bay in Kenya, Africa, has a capacity of 123 bed patients. "That's with the beds about one and a half feet apart," the doctor explains. In an average year 5,600 inpatients and 45,000 outpatients are treated at the hospital, he says.

In spite of buildings in poor condition, the hospital operates a training school for young Africans, reports Dr. Sturdevant. Courses are taught in nursing and midwifery. In 1967, the hospital began a medical technology course.

"AS LATE AS 1967 there was only one qualified African technologist in all of Kenya," the

doctor says. "The nearest hospital to ours is in Kisii, a town 25 miles away. Almost half of our patients are Kisii tribesmen," he adds.

Dr. Sturdevant, formerly a physician in private practice in Puyallup, Wash., has been medical director of the Kendu Hospital since March, 1966. He is a graduate of Loma Linda University.

A special offering will be taken at the Torrance Church Sautrday earmarked for Kendu Hospital. Other Adventist Churches throughout the United States and Canada will also contribute.

Drama of Last Meal Re-enacted

The Wayfarers' Chapel, Lloyd Wright's glass-and tree Church-by-the-sea at Portuguese Bend, is offering a special worship service Sunday afternoon at 5 p.m.

The Chapel Choir under the direction of Dorothy Simpson, will re-enact the Meal in the Upper Room, commemorated by Da Vinci's famous painting, "The Last Supper," at which Jesus Christ instituted the Christian Communion Service.
