Mental Health Conference Set

Los Angeles County's new plan for providing mental health services under legislation going into effect July 1 will be explained at a 9 a.m. conference and workshop Friday at the Jewish Community Center, 2601 Grand Ave., Long Beach.

The conference will be sponsored by the Mental Health Development Commission of the Welfare Planning Council, Los Angeles Region, an agency of United Way, in cooperation with the Los Angeles County Mental Health Department.

Dr. Robert E. Thomas, regional mental health director, State Department of Mental Hygiene, will represent Dr. James V. Lowry, department director, in a discussion of the provisions and objectives of the Lanterman-Petris-Short Act which revises segments of the Short-Doyle Act.

Dr. Donald Schwartz, deputy director of the Los Angeles

County Department of Mental Health, will represent Dr. Harry R. Brickman, department director, in a review of the new county plan for mental health services. Also participating in the discussion will be regional chiefs of area mental health services, including Drs. Calmeze H. Dudley, Southeast, Robert M. Newhouse, Long Beach, and Richard H. Hartman, South Bay.

Maurice Schwarz Jr., chairman of the Mental Health Development Commission, will preside at the conference for Mental Health Area 3, which includes Inglewood, Torrance, South, San Antonio, Compton, Bellflower, Whittier, Long Beach, and Harbor districts.

Assisting in the conference plans are the Long Beach Community Welfare Council and the Welfare Planning Councils of the Harbor and the South-east areas.

State Convention for Emblem Clubs Planned

Purple and gold banners, the colors of the Emblem Club, will be on display along with the American flag today, through Saturday, as the California State Association of Emblem Clubs and Nevada Clubs holds its 17th annual convention at the International Hotel in Los Angeles.

Approximately 1,200 members, representing a membership of more than 12,500 in 92 clubs of the association, will attend. Mrs. B. M. Camron of Van Nuys, a past president of San Fernando Emblem Club, will preside over the convention.

"Our Living Emblem Tree," is the theme for the year. The membership is comprised of wives, sisters, mothers, and daughters of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks.

Community service projects supported annually include the annual scholarships for the deaf and hard of hearing, equipping hospital rooms, free dental clinics, glasses for the needy, audio-visual equipment, hospital and mentally retarded training programs. The California Elks' Cerebral Pal-

sy Fund of more than \$100,000 is supported by Emblem Clubs throughout the state. The California-Nevada State Association has given \$10,000 in scholarships this year.

Mrs. Robert Shinning, past president of Pasadena Emblem Club, is serving as general chairman of the convention assisted by Mrs. James Frazier of Pasadena. Los Angeles Councilman Ernani Bernardi and Floyd Marengo, Exalted Ruler of the San Fernando Elks' Lodge, will address the opening session tomorrow.
