

LAST SERVICES IN THE OLD LOMITA CHURCH

Impressive services marked the last Sunday in the old Lomita church building. In the morning a large congregation participated in the observance of the Sacrament of the Lord's Supper. The pastor's message answered the question, "What mean ye by this service?" It is a service in memory of the death of Christ. It is a communion in which all who observe this feast receive grace and blessing from Him. It is a service of thanksgiving, called the Eucharist. Finally it is a sacrament, an oath of love and loyalty which the believing disciple pledges to his Master Jesus Christ.

In the evening a memorial service was held. It is thirteen years since the first church was organized, and the old building erected. Elder L. J. Hunter, identified with the church for eleven years, gave an interesting account of the history of the church from the beginning to the present time. It was first the Union Evangelical Christian church of Lomita. Eight years after its organization it was changed by vote of the congregation to the First Presbyterian church of Lomita. Recently the corporate name was changed to the Community Presbyterian church of Lomita.

The pastor gave some facts and figures of the work of the church in the three years of his pastorate. Sixty persons have united with the church during that time, thirty-five by confession or re-affirmation of faith and twenty-five by letter. Twenty-three have been baptized, three adults and twenty infants. At the morning service Mrs. Bromley was heard in a beautiful solo and in the evening the choir under the direction of Mr. Harold Coackley, with Mrs. Charles Clark as organist, sang very effectively the anthem, Praise Ye the Lord.

C. A. "Chic" Curtiss sang at the annual concert of the Ellis Club, at the Philharmonic auditorium, Los Angeles, Tuesday afternoon. This club consists of one hundred male members, of which Mr. Curtiss has the honor to be one of the number. Mrs. C. N. Curtiss, and Mrs. F. L. 
