PALOS VERDES ART JURY NOW BUSY PLANNING

Spanish, French, and Italian types of architecture for the homes to be built at Palos Verdes, the proposed \$35,000,000 city between Redondo and Los Angeles Harbor and adjoining Harbor City on the south, were given serious consideration last week at the first meeting of the art jury of the project held at the Redondo Beach hotel.

The art jury, which includes E. G. Lewis, general manager of the Palos Verdes Estates; Myron Hunt, Frederick Law Olmsted, Charles H. Cheney, David C. Allison, and Robert D. Faruher, will have supervision over the building of all homes, parks, boulevards and municipal structures of the new city.

It was pointed out by Mr. Lewis that the foregoing types of architecture should have a strong appeal to the home owner desiring to build in the warm southern climate. He stated, however, that many discussions of the subject will be held before a definite decision is made on this particular plan for the project.

Plans for three townsites with many photographs of examples of architecture in Southern California and in Europe were presented to the jury by Mr. Cheney, but no final action was taken, the jury agreeing to meet again next week and weekly thereafter until the general plan of the property now being made for convertible note-holders to make their selections is completed in December.

Frederick Law Olmsted, general director of design for the Palos Verdes project, presented several subjects of importance and participated in the deliberations of the jury.

"The Palos Verdes art jury is a permanent and semi-public body established by the Palos Verdes project, primarily to act in a judicial and advisory capacity to those who construct buildings, plant trees and shrubs or otherwise improve any lands of the Palos Verdes estates," said Mr. Cheney.

"It is to be permanently endowed with the sum of \$300,000, the income from which is to be used to pay three prominent architects, a city planner and two laymen nominated by a university and the Palos Verdes Home Association, when organized, co-operating with the general manager to complete the board.

"It will be the duty of the jury to pass on and approve everything built on the project, to see that an active standard of design is maintained and to protect all purchasers from unsightly and inharmonious structures. It also is empowered to encourage art education and municipal embellishment."

Building To Cost More, Is Belief

Indications that homebuilding costs for 1923 will be higher than those of 1922 are seen in the general advance of costs in almost every line of building material.
