

ORDINANCE NO. 52

ESTABLISHING STREET GRADES ON 218TH STREET BETWEEN CABRILLO AVENUE AND MANUEL AVENUE, ON 220TH STREET, 222D STREET AND PLAZA DEL AMO, BETWEEN MARTINA AVENUE AND CABRILLO AVENUE, ON CABRILLO AVENUE, ANDREO AVENUE, AND GRAMERCY AVENUE, BETWEEN CARSON STREET AND PLAZA DEL AMO, ON MARTINA AVENUE, BETWEEN CARSON STREET AND 222D STREET, ON MANUEL AVENUE BETWEEN CARSON STREET AND 218TH STREET, ON MADRID AVENUE, AMAPOLA AVENUE AND COTA AVENUE, BETWEEN CARSON STREET AND DOMINGUEZ AVENUE, AND ON DOMINGUEZ STREET, 208TH STREET, 210TH STREET, REDONDO BOULEVARD, 214TH STREET AND 216TH STREET, BETWEEN COTA AVENUE AND MADRID AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance do ordain as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 54

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSTRUCTION, ALTERATION REPAIRING AND REVIVING OF BUILDINGS IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE, PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF PERMITS FOR THE SAME, AND FOR THE PROTECTION OF LIFE AND PROPERTY FROM FIRE, AND ALSO PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF A BUILDING INSPECTOR."

The Board of Trustees of the City of Torrance, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 26 of an ordinance entitled "An ordinance regulating the construction, alteration, repairing and removing of buildings in the City of Torrance providing for the issuance of permits for the same, and for the protection of life and property from fire, and also providing for the appointment of a building inspector" is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

This section shall not be construed to prevent additions being built to buildings heretofore constructed in said district which have been constructed of hollow tile, and which may be of not more than one story in height.

Section 2. Section 27 of said last mentioned ordinance is hereby amended by adding thereto the following paragraph:

Any porch shall not be construed to be a part of the building to which it is attached, but no part of any porch or other appurtenance to any building shall be built nearer than fourteen feet to the front property line of any lot

nor nearer than five feet to the side property line of any lot facing on a side street when there are other lots in rear of said lot in the same block and which front on said side street; nor nearer than three feet to any other side line of any lot.

The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of the foregoing ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Torrance Herald, a weekly newspaper printed, published, and circulated in the City of Torrance and hereby designated for that purpose, and thereupon and thereafter this ordinance shall be in full force and effect.
