An unofficial four-reel picture portraying the destruction of Tokio and Yokohama by earthquake is ready for distribution by the visual department of the University of California extension department. Hon. U. Oyama, consul-general of Japan in San Francisco, has made this picture available to communities, saying in his letter to a California official of the American Red Cross:  
"What I desire is to have the films shown as widely as possible in order to acquaint the American people with the extent of destruction and the activities of the American relief work for which the Japanese people is most grateful."  
This picture, which was taken on the spot, gives glimpses of the stricken area, details of the disaster, and Japan's prompt beginnings of reconstruction.
