

## EMERGENCY COMMITTEE POINTS OUT FOOT AND MOUTH DANGER



Will we be able to ship our crops once it gets a foothold. Quarantine regulations can not be left alone and solely to the delegated federal and state authorities. Every citizen, man, woman and child, must feel their individual responsibility and bend every effort to stop this oncoming plague menace.

The foot and mouth disease has moved since February 18, 1924, from West Oakland to all the Bay counties, jumped to Merced county, and from Merced county to Los Angeles county, and within the past week to Kern county at Bakersfield. We are practically surrounded. The accompanying illustration shows the infected areas and the dates on which the disease was discovered.

We print below, in full, the quarantine regulations. Observe them in every detail, for thereby may depend the very life of our community.

The foot and mouth disease seems to be limited to cloven-hoofed animals. It is extremely infectious and moves with lightning-like rapidity
